1. मतिओळियै विद्महे आत्मबलायै धीमहि ।

तन्नो लक्ष्मी प्रचोदयात् ॥

Mathioliyai vidmahe Aathma balaayai dheemahi |

Tanno Lakshmi prachodayaath ||

மதிஒளியை வித்மஹே ஆத்ம பலாயை தீமஹி |

தந்நோ லக்ஷ்மீ ப்ரசோதயாத் ||

ಮಥಿಒಲಿಯೈ ವಿದ್ಮಹೆ ಆತ್ಮ ಬಲಾಯೈ ಧೀಮಹಿ |

These two Gayathri Mantraas, when chanted together invoke the blessings of the three “Devis – Maha Lakshmi, Maha Kaali and Maha Saraswathy and the showering of the three shaktis – Icha shakti, Kriya shakti and Gnana shakti embodied in our Mentor Mathioli Saraswathy.

The first Gayathri Mantra was composed by Ms. R. Rajalakshmi on Sri Akka during the Dasara celebrations 2007. Inspired by the first Gayathri Mantra, the second Gayathri Mantra was composed by Dr. S. Kannan & Mr. K. Shankaran. These were released and chanted for public on 1st January 2008 in the august presence of Sri Akka.
